(Eva PRIESTER of the Austrian Communist Volksstimme relates in the Nepszabadsag what allegedly happened on the Austro-Hungarian border during the Hungarian revolution. Dealing with the further fate of refugees coming to Austria she writes as follows:)

In Salzburg there are 4 so-called transit-camps inhabited by such 'refugees' who await their visa to the USA. These camps are being managed either by American organizations like the Free Europe Committee or such associations which play a vital role in anti-People's Democratic movements as e.g. the International Church Council..... Around the 28th of October there were new things to be experienced on the border. Representatives of the revolutionary councils, the first from Magyarovar and Gyoeer, appeared on the Austrian side of the border. They negotiated with Americans and West-Germans, especially with staff-members of RFE. It is to be mentioned that despite the neutrality of Austria RFE is still operating in Salzburg.....
