The reception of the Petofi station will be improved by the building up of the ultra-short wave network.

In answer to the question whether the radio sets now in use will be capable of receiving the new wave length, the director answered: "They are already constructing an adapter, with the aid of which almost all former sets can be tuned in for ultra-short wave reception. The more powerful new radios are being manufactured for the reception of long, middle, short and ultra-short-wave lengths. These radios will be first used on trains, trucks and other branches of transportation."

About TV in the new Five Year Plan

In the new Plan, we are building a 30 kilowatt station, which will supply not only Budapest and its vicinity with high-quality picture and sound energy, but also more distant regions, for instance Szekesfehervar (67 kilometers from Budapest). The Miskolc (110 kilometers from Budapest) television station is the first step in the building-up of a countrywide TV network.
