The Hungarian operetta "Boci, boci tarka" (German title: Das buntgescheckte Kalb) was shown for the first time in East Germany at ROSTOCK on March 3, 1956.

The newspaper reports that the operetta is "progressive" and that it has been composed by 50-year-old Otto VINCZE. The libretto by Matyás CSIZMAREK was translated into German by Ita SZENT-IVANYI. The staging was accomplished by Hans SALOMON.

According to the "Ostsee Zeitung," the operetta breathes champagne and paprika. The work of all artists was received with strong applause. Members of the Hungarian Embassy in East BERLIN were present at the first performance in ROSTOCK.
