

Budapest: Bid to UN Cited

The Hungarian Foreign Office has said its invitation to Dag Hammarskjöld to visit Hungary has not been answered officially yet, but "we would regret" a refusal by the United Nations Secretary-General. The May 6 announcement also said 20,000 Hungarians have returned home from the West, but accused the United States, French, and Turkish Governments of preventing others from returning.
