B.B.C. Material to Geneva

You mentioned the need for having a second series covering Hungary sent to Geneva in addition to having the present material routed to Geneva.

This could be done as follows:

- 1) Through the H.Q. Library ^{ack} as the B.B.C. Monitoring Service to dispatch Part II B of its Summary of World Broadcasts to you (in your name c/o Director of the Library Palais des Nations, Geneva). This should cover all numbers of Part II B from # 775 onwards.
- 2) As of the receipt of the United Nations letter, the B.B.C. Service ~~will be requested~~ to extract Part II B which is normally dispatched to New York, and to route it to the Geneva Office as per paragraph 1 above. (The remainder would be sent as usual to New York).
- 3) Dispatches to Geneva should cease, unless otherwise informed, for any material published after Monday 8 April. This should be re-addressed to United Nations, New York, (in accordance with the present system).
- 4) We will notify the B.B.C. Service at a later date regarding the discontinuance of the extra copy of Part II B.
