

The Inter-Parliamentary Union Conference: Statement by Ronai

Sandor Ronai and Erik Molnar, two of the Hungarian delegates to the Inter-Parliamentary Union's conference in London, returned to Budapest on 21st September. Janos Peter, the third member of the delegation, joined the Hungarian delegation at the 12th UN Assembly. (Budapest 20.00, 21.9.57)

In a statement to MTI, Ronai, who is President of the Hungarian Assembly, said that both the agenda and the debates had proved the importance of the part played by the Inter-Parliamentary Union in international life.

Forthcoming Visits by Parliamentary Delegations

He had invited representatives of various parliamentary groups to visit Hungary, Ronai added. Delegations from India, Indonesia, Burma and the Sudan would shortly be arriving in Hungary. Egyptian Deputies had also stressed their wish to visit Hungary soon. Members of the Hungarian delegation had been able to meet Deputies of several other countries. This had given them a chance to tell them the truth about the position in Hungary and to inform them of the country's economic and political consolidation. (MTI 22.9.57)
