Budapest Water Shortage Worse: In consequence of the dry and cold weather, the water-level of the Danube is continuing to fall. The water works are doing their best to obtain additional drinking water from new wells as quickly as possible. An all-out effort is being made to connect 25 wells at Szentendre Island with the mains in a few days' time. New wells are also being sunk at Bekasmegyer and Szigetszentmiklos. The City Council and the water works most emphatically remind the population of the need for the utmost economy with water. Night restrictions remain in force every Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. Industrial restrictions must be most scrupulously enforced.
