COPY OF SAVINGRAM NO. 697 FROM THE NAN TOU COUNTY COUNCIL

To the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Taipei. Please forward the following to the General Assembly of the United Nations.

The former Hungarian Premier, Mr. Nagy, the former Minister of National Defense, Mr. Maleter and other Hungarian freedom fighters have been executed for their participation in the national revolutionary movement. The people of all free and democratic countries were profoundly shocked by the news. They are bitterly indignant at the cruelties of the Soviet imperialists and the Hungarian puppets. The undersigned, representing the 370,000 inhabitants of the County, in protest against the atrocities of the Soviet Union, request the United Nations to deprive the Government of the Soviet imperialists and that of the Hungarian puppets of their membership in the Organization and to effect the immediate release of other freedom fighters who are still held in imprisonment for their defence of justice and human rights.
