NOTE

The Belgian Ministry of Foreign Affairs has been informed by the Secretary-General of the United Nations that the Special Committee on Hungary would like to receive information on the situation referred to in General Assembly resolution 449 (XI) of 10 January 1957 from the Governments of Members of the United Nations which had diplomatic representatives in Budapest at the time.

The Belgian Department of Foreign Affairs has had an opportunity of perusing the report on the subject already submitted to the Special Committee by the United Kingdom Government.

The information in its possession in no way invalidates the information furnished in the United Kingdom report but, on the contrary confirms its accuracy.
