The Assembly of Captive European Nations will meet in plenary session on Friday, December 9, 1960, at 10:00 a.m., on the eve of Human Rights Day, at the Carnegie Endowment International Center, 46th Street and United Nations Plaza, to commemorate the 12th anniversary of the adoption of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. The main point on the agenda will be the violation of human rights in Eastern Europe. The Assembly will also consider a report and draft resolution on Collectivization of Agriculture in the Captive Countries.
