THE HUNGARIAN REFUGEES IN AUSTRIA.

The latest statistics about Hungarian refugees in Austria were published with the date of October 10. Since the end of August only three Hungarians have succeeded in breaking through the Iron Curtain. The number of Hungarian refugees who arrived in Austria since November 1956 is 174,290. 145,760 or 83.6% left in the meantime for the West or for overseas countries. Later 2,127 returned again to Austria. 5,480 were repatriated from Austria directly to Hungary. The number of refugees who are still in Austria is 22,970 and 10,270 of them live in camps still. According to the statistical data the whereabouts of 80 persons is unknown. They are probably agents who have disappeared from the camps without any trace.
